

Fishing Gear checklist

YOUR PASSPORT !

Clothing:

**** Rain gear, a must for your day long comfort**

Hooded sweatshirt for layering under your rain gear, it can be cool in early June

Waterproof shoes/boots

Long sleeved shirts and pants to protect from the sun

Hat and polarized sunglasses

Insulated undergarments in case of cold weather in early season

Dry bag

Fishing Equipment:

Bring your own fishing gear—Not furnished by Crow Duck

One 6' or 6'6" medium or medium-light jigging rod (spool with 6-8 # test mono)

One 7' bait casting rod (spool with 14 – 17# test)

Assortment of jigs (1/8 to 3/8 oz. assorted colors)

Rapala lures

Original and Husky Jerk

Shallow divers (F-9)

Mid range (HJ11 or 13)

Deep divers (TDD 13)

Spoons (ex. Whitefish or Red Devil)

Package of Powerbait or Gulp (white or chartreuse)

Bottom bouncers and snells

Needle nose pliers

Stringer for shore lunch fish

Small cooler to take with you in the boat for drinks, minnows and crawlers.

Misc:

Sun screen

Tums or Roloids

Bug Repellent

Camera
